

**TO : ALL HEADS OF GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENT OWNED AND CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS**

**SUBJECT : PARTICIPATION IN THE GREEN PHILIPPINES PROGRAM**

**DATE : JUL 24 2007**

Pursuant to the Green Philippines Program of this Administration, you are hereby directed to actively participate in the implementation of the Program through the following:

1. Adopt a planting site for development, care, maintenance and protection.
2. Mobilize your personnel and stakeholders to participate in the thematic tree planting namely: 1) protected areas, critical watersheds and open lands; 2) mangroves and coastal areas; 3) agroforestry and fruit trees; and 4) urban parks, green campuses, camps and subdivisions.
3. Assist in the advocacy campaign to ensure awareness, appreciation and participation by all sectors in the program.
4. Provide other support that may be needed by the Program.

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall take the lead and undertake the necessary coordination on the participation of government agencies.

The DENR is also directed to submit a report on the conduct of the program, including the participation of government agencies, through the Executive Secretary, copy furnished the Presidential Management Staff.
