e-TRAINING FOR SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS TEACHERS 2007

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Schools

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the University of Sto. Tomas and selected e-Training Network Institutions nationwide, announces the implementation of the e-Training for Science and Mathematics Teachers 2007.
2. The e-Training for Science and Mathematics Teachers 2007 is an on-line training designed to upgrade the competencies of science and mathematics teachers in the elementary level which will run for ten (10) months starting November 2007 to August 2008. The subjects areas to be offered are as follows:
 - a. Elementary Science Grades 3 and 4
 - b. Elementary Science Grades 5 and 6
 - c. Elementary Mathematics Grades 3 and 4
 - d. Elementary Mathematics Grades 5 and 6
3. The participants to the training are teachers teaching science and mathematics subjects in the elementary grades who:
 - a. are Filipino citizens teaching in the Philippines;
 - b. are actually teaching the science/mathematics subjects in public or private schools but is a non-major in that subject;
 - c. have basic computer and internet skills;
 - d. be willing to learn online;
 - e. have reliable access to internet;
 - f. have not attended any RSTC teacher-training program; and
 - g. be willing to sign a scholarship contract with the DOST-SEI.
4. This on-line training will be conducted by the following e-Training Network Institutions:
 - a. Saint Louis University, Baguio City
 - b. Mariano Marcos State University, Laoag City
 - c. Saint Mary's University, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya
 - d. Central Luzon State University, Science City of Munoz, Nueva Ecija
 - e. Bicol University, Legazpi City
 - f. West Visayas State University, Iloilo City
 - g. University of San Carlos, Cebu City

- h. Western Mindanao State University, Zamboanga City
- i. Xavier University, Cagayan de Oro City
- j. Ateneo de Davao University, Davao City
- k. Notre Dame of Marbel University, Koronadal City
- l. Mindanao State University, Marawi City.

5. Qualified and interested applicants may fill out the application forms at www.e-training.ph not later than September 24, 2007. The Certification Form of the Principal/Head of Institution which should be downloaded from the same website must be received by DOST-SEI not later than October 1, 2007.

6. The applicants to the training will receive the Notice of Acceptance or Non-Acceptance by email as soon as his/her complete application forms have been evaluated. The Scholarship Contract and Letter of Conforme accompany the Notice of Acceptance. Applicants should fill up the return slip of the Notice of Acceptance form to confirm acceptance of the scholarship grant. The principal or head of the institution should also sign the Scholarship Contract and the Letter of Conforme as witness. Accomplished Notice of Acceptance Form should be emailed to acceptance@e-training.ph as soon as possible.

7. To be enrolled to the training, the signed Scholarship Contract and Letter of Conforme must be mailed to the address below not later than October 12, 2007:



8. The participants for each course will attend a one-day face-to-face orientation at the e-training institutions nearest to their schools/residences on November 10, 2007.

9. Each participant will be provided with:

- a. waived training fee of Six Thousand Pesos (PhP 6,000.00) for the duration of the training;
- b. internet allowance of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 500.00) per month for 10 months;
- c. round trip transportation expenses during the orientation session, midterm and final examinations; and
- d. 50% of the cost of People's PC at Seven Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (PhP7,600.00) (if the participant decides to purchase a computer from the Procurement Service of the Department of Budget and Management).

10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
