MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING COURSES (ELCs)

- 1. The Teacher Education Council (TEC), in coordination with the Regional Offices of the Department of Education (DepED) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), conducted a series of Zonal Workshops on the Implementation of the ELCs (DepED Memorandum No. 272, s. 2007).
- 2. Participants to the zonal workshops were Regional Directors/Assistant Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents/Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Principals, Resource and Cooperating Teachers from the DepED; Regional Directors, Teacher Education Supervisors, Deans, Colleges of Education, Field Study/Practice Teaching Supervisors from CHED Offices and TEIs.
- 3. The participants, under the leadership of the Regional Director and the Schools Division Superintendent, are expected to:
  - a. monitor and evaluate the delivery and effective use of the ELC Handbook provided each region, division, school, and TEI;
  - b. conduct cascading parallel workshops to the division personnel/staff, school heads, department heads, resource and classroom teachers for mass implementation of the ELCs; and
  - c. monitor and evaluate the Division Implementation Plan, the School Improvement Plan (SIP), and the Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) which were outputs during the zonal workshops.
- 4. Enclosed is Enclosure No. 1 of DepED Memorandum No. 272, s. 2007 as reference for the local trainings.
- 5. The ELC Handbooks were packed by School/City Division indicating the number of schools by District. It is expected that public elementary and secondary schools in the school/city divisions should receive their copies duly acknowledged from the Schools Division/City Superintendents and properly recorded by the Supply Officers of the division and the schools. The distribution of the Handbooks shall be closely monitored by the school/city divisions. Hence, a copy of the Memorandum Receipt shall be furnished the TEC, telefax no. 638-6172 for accounting and auditing purposes.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
