SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES FOR THE NATIONAL ENGLISH PROFICIENCY  
PROGRAM (NEPP) FOR LAST QUARTER (2007)

To: Regional Directors

Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The National English Proficiency Program (NEPP) in support of the Bureaus of Elementary and Secondary Education will conduct different activities for the months of November and December 2007, respectively (list enclosed).
2. The series of activities are aimed at:
  - For Elementary Mentoring**
    - a. finalizing the modules for CLT;
    - b. conducting a CLT Training of Trainers for Muslim teachers of Regions IX, XII, and ARMM;
    - c. conducting an Action Research on CLT, 2C2IA, WBL for Regions I, VIII and CARAGA;
    - d. administering the SAT- ComTeach, Phase II, Grades 1, 2 and 3, USAID-EQuALLS ARMM, Regions XI and XII;
  - For Secondary Mentoring**
    - e. conducting Phase II-MTP special batch;
    - f. conducting orientation of administrators (Thought Leadership) special batch; and
    - g. giving an enhancement training to the trained mentors.
3. Participants to the different activities will be notified through invitation and other forms of announcements. Teacher-participants from ARMM and Region IX will be facilitated by EQuALLS-EDC team for SAT.
4. Expenses for the conduct of these activities shall be charged to NEPP funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. These include stipend allowance, board and lodging, travel expenses of the resource persons/writers, management and staff, supplies, training kit, freight and other incidental expenses. However, expenses for the conduct of SAT-ComTeach will be shouldered by USAID-EQuALLS.
