TRAINING-WORKSHOP IN DOING INVESTIGATORY PROJECTS IN SCIENCE AND
MATHEMATICS FOR REGIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOLS

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) through the Curriculum Development division (CDD) shall conduct the **Training Workshop for Regional Science High Schools (RSHSs) in Doing Investigatory Projects in Science and Mathematics** on November 26-30, 2007 at Marikina Hotel, Marikina City.
2. The activity aims to equip science and mathematics teachers with knowledge and skills in doing science investigatory projects and to enhance their mastery and competence in teaching research in science and mathematics.
3. The regional participants shall be the following: one (1) school head of each RSHS, two (2) research science teachers and two (2) mathematics teachers (one (1) Third Year mathematics teacher and one (1) Fourth Year mathematics teacher) handling mathematics investigatory projects. First meal shall be morning snack on November 26 and last meal shall be lunch on November 30, 2007.
4. The regional participants are requested to bring at least two laptops per subject, and on-going science/mathematics investigatory projects.
5. Science/Mathematics teacher-participants may arrange their time schedules with other teachers in the school to avoid disruption of classes.
6. Travel expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses of regional participants from official station to the workshop venue shall be charged against local funds while travel expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses of resource/speakers, BSE Management staff, honoraria of resource/speakers, extra duty allowance of BSE management staff relative to the activity shall be charged against OSEC Funds Operational Expenses of the RSHSs subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
