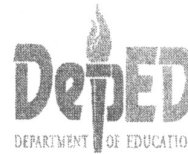

**CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOP USING ICT IN EDUCATION TOOLKIT FOR
POLICYMAKERS, PLANNERS AND PRACTITIONERS**

1. The Department of Education (DepED) in coordination with UNESCO and INNOTECH will hold a four-day workshop entitled "**Capacity Building Workshop Using the Online ICT in Education Toolkit for Policymakers, Planners and Practitioners**" at the SEAMEO-INNOTECH in Commonwealth Avenue, UP Diliman, Quezon City on November 26-29, 2007.

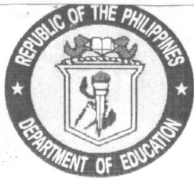
