SAMa-SAMa SA ESKWELA SCHOOL TOUR

- 1. The Department of Education-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepED-CSCA) is strengthening efforts in generating renewed optimism and support to education. The CSCA, as the pupil/student affairs office of the Department of Education, is interested in tapping human interests and inspirations embodied by role models in our society to draw out significant positive action from the impressionistic young pupils/students, especially those in the public school system. Given somebody they can easily relate to and identify with, and who they can readily emulate, our pupils/students will be inspired to realize the importance of education, continue being in school, battle the odds of education and learn harder.
- 2. Pursuant thereto, the Department of Education has designated Sam Concepcion, a multi-awarded and talented young artist, as the new DepED-CSCA Youth Spokesperson and Role Model. Sam Concepcion was chosen based on his accomplishments both as a student and as an artist whose outstanding character is genuine and is not built on image alone.
- 3. To actualize Sam Concepcion's role as Youth Spokesperson and Role Model, the Department of Education will conduct a nationwide school tour dubbed as SAMa-SAMa sa Eskwela. The school tour is a relevant youth mini-concert featuring Sam Concepcion with his triple-treat talents interspersed with important messages on family, education, nation-building and many more. It is a celebration of the youth's indomitable spirit to succeed despite the many challenges of adolescence through the many skills and talents learned inside the school. The concert will culminate in a Pledge of Commitment to be recited by all pupils/students and signed by officers of the Supreme Pupil Government (SPG) or the Supreme Student Government (SSG).
- 4. In the secondary level, the SAMa-SAMa sa Eskwela School Tour shall be under the project of all the Supreme Student Governments (SSG) nationwide and the various Federations, which shall lead coordination and its implementation in the School, Division, Regional and National levels, respectively. In the elementary level, it shall be under the project of the Supreme Pupil Government (SPG).
- 5. The SPG/SSG Advisers in the school level and the respective Education Supervisors incharge of the Student Government Program (SGP) in the Division and Regional Offices shall assist in the coordination and implementation of the school tour.

- 6. Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents and School Principals/Heads are advised to actively support this undertaking.

SAMa-SAMa SA ESKWELA SCHOOL TOUR

MECHANICS

1. School Identification

Based on a pre-determined schedule, the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) will request the Regional Office/Division Office through the Regional Director/Schools Division Superintendent and attention the Student Government Program (SGP) Regional Coordinator/Division Coordinator for a list of recommended schools where the SAMa-SAMa sa Eskwela School Tour will be held. A School or Division or Regional Office may, however, also request the CSCA to schedule a SAMa-SAMa sa Eskwela School Tour.

The recommendation shall be based on the size of the population of the school and availability of the logistics (stage and sound system). Schools with a lot of youthrelated delinquencies (smoking, alcohol drinking, drug abuse and low academic performance is preferred.

Once the schools are identified, the SGP Regional Coordinator and/or Division Coordinator shall promptly inform the Division Superintendent and/or the School Principal concerned and advise their respective SGP Division Coordinator and/or Supreme Student Government Adviser for the needed preparations.

The list of the schools must be submitted a week before the scheduled date of the activity to the CSCA with all the necessary information (name of school, school principal, contact number and address).

2. Coordination

This being a project of the Supreme Student Governments (SSG) and its Federations in the secondary level, coordination will be done primarily by the SSG officers and the SSG Advisers in the school level, Division Federation of Supreme Student Governments Officers and the SGP Division Coordinators in the Division Level and the Regional Federation of Supreme Student Governments Officers and the SGP Regional Coordinators in the Regional Level.

In the elementary level, the School Principal and the SPG adviser will coordinate the holding of the school tour.

The CSCA will send its representatives for the detailed coordination.

3. Standard Program/Program Flow

The School Tour shall follow the standard program/program flow as stated below:

Invocation Host School (pupils/students to perform) Philippine National Anthem Host School (pupils/students to perform)

Welcome Remarks Host Principal SPG/SSG President Messages Division Superintendent

Regional Director/Other DepED Official

"I Am Not Forgotten" Sam Concepcion

Intermission numbers or any additional numbers/activities must be coordinated with the Program Director/Representative from the CSCA.

4. Emcee/Program Director

The emcees must be pupils/students of the host school who must be active and language proficient. The mini-concert shall be coordinated by a Program Director from the CSCA.

5. Pupil/Student Participation

All pupils/students, including the School Principal and teachers, are enjoined to be present during the SAMa-SAMa sa Eskwela and actively participate therein.

6. Security/Crowd Control

It is a must that a security/crowd control group be organized to avoid untoward incidents associated with related activities. Teacher-advisers of classes must be on hand to instill discipline and order. The Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts must be designated to also assist in this activity.

7. Venue/Stage Set-Up

The venue must be inside the school in a gym or covered court with seats properly arranged for the activity. Stage set-up must be minimal and should only contain the following text design to be prepared by the Supreme Pupil Government or the Supreme Student Government:

8. Sound System

The school must provide a good sound system. It must at least be appropriate or compatible for singing.

9. Pledge of Commitment

The Pledge of Commitment must be prepared in advance by the officers of the Supreme Pupil Government or the Supreme Student Government (SSG) in a white cartolina or printed on a tarpaulin streamer following the format below:

The Pledge of Commitment shall be signed by Sam Concepcion together with the officers of the Supreme Pupil Government or the Supreme Student Government. It shall be posted in the bulletin board of the SPG/SSG afterwards.
