SECOND DEPED-MTAP NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MATHEMATICS EDUCATION

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED) will conduct the Second DepED-MTAP National Conference on Mathematics Education on April 15-18, 2008 at the ECOTECH Center, Lahug, Cebu City and April 22-25, 2008 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The theme of the Conference is "Revitalizing Mathematics Education for Progress".

2. The conference aims to:

- enhance the knowledge and skills of elementary and secondary school heads and mathematics teachers to produce graduates who are independent and life-long learners;
- b. strengthen the commitment of mathematics teachers to their vocation as molders of the youth;
- c. acquaint mathematics teacher educators from Teacher Education Institutes of the demands of mathematics teachers in the field so as to align the preparation of pre-service elementary and secondary teachers to equip them with the knowledge and skills expected of them;
- d. provide a venue for the sharing of experiences in integrating ICT in the teaching of mathematics; and
- e. develop a network of mathematics teachers, school heads and teacher educators that will work together towards excellence in mathematics education.
- 3. The participants in the conference are the principals and mathematics teachers of elementary and secondary public and private schools, regional, division and district supervisors involved in mathematics teaching, heads and mathematics teachers from Teacher Education Institutes.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) shall be charged each participant who will pay on or before March 7, 2008 and Four Thousand Pesos (PhP 4,000.00) for those who will pay after March 7 but on or before March 22, 2008. The fee will cover the travel, honoraria and board and lodging of resource persons, meals (from supper of Day 0 to lunch of Day 3),

board and lodging, conference materials, certificates of attendance and participation, conference bag, and miscellaneous expenses. Participation is on a first-come, first-served basis. The organizers cannot guarantee a place to any interested person who has not paid by March 22, 2008. Enclosed is an application form.

- 5. Payment of the registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) or Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) is to be deposited to the MTAP Account No. 3540-045 75-6 in any Metrobank branch. The application form and the deposit slip are to be sent to MTAP through fax no. (02) 912-5249 or (02) 709-0447 indicating the name and address of the depositor and the branch of Metrobank.
- 6. Any clarification may be made at telefax no. (02) 912-5249 or (02) 709-0447.
- 7. Members of the different working committees are authorized to travel one or two days before the conference according to the need.
