2008 NATIONAL ENGLISH JAZZ CHANTS FESTIVAL (Search for Best Speaker in English)

- 1. The Oro Eco Enterprises with World Class Language Center is sponsoring the 2008 National English Jazz Chants Festival (NEJCF). This will be held on April 1-3, 2008 at Subic, Olongapo City. The mechanics of the contest are found in *Enclosure No. 1*.
- 2. This festival aims to promote oral English proficiency and creative interpretation of jazz chants by high school students and teacher-coaches.
- 3. The participants to this activity will be the public high schools from the 17 regions led by teachers who attended the 2007 DepED-Convergys Oral Communications Training in Makati or Cebu. Each teacher will form a group of 15 of his/her students for the Jazz Chants Team.
- 4. There will be three phases for this National English Jazz Chants Festival:
 - a. Phase 1 Division English Jazz Chants Festival. This will be held in the division among schools with teachers who are Convergystrained with their team of 15 students. (see Enclosure No. 2);
 - b. Phase 2 Regional English Jazz Chants Festival. Division winners will compete in the Regional English Jazz Chants Festival which will be monitored by the NEJCF Management Team as scheduled (see Enclosure No. 3). Only one winner-team per region will be selected (see Enclosure No. 4). The trophy for the regional winner will be provided by the NEJCF Team; and
 - c. *Phase 3* National English Jazz Chants Festival. Regional winners will come to Subic, Olongapo City to compete. For details, please see Enclosure Nos. 5, 6, and 7.
- 5. The participants to the National English Jazz Chants Festival are expected to be at the venue a day before the contest. Travel expenses, board and lodging and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Oro Eco Enterprises will be responsible for the travel expenses, board and lodging, honoraria, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses of the board of judges and management team.
- 6. There will be four (4) national winners: one (1) from Luzon; one (1) from Visayas; one (1) from Mindanao and one (1) grand champion or the Best Speaker in English. Each winning team will receive PhP5,000.00 while the grand champion will receive PhP10,000.00. Each of the four will also receive plaque of recognition. The four (4) winning teacher-coaches will be entitled to a 3-day trip to Singapore to visit RELC-SEAMEO for free.

MECHANICS OF THE CONTEST

Phase 1: The division will conduct a one day competition known as DIVISION ENGLISH JAZZ CHANTS FESTIVAL (DEJCF) within either third or fourth week of February, 2008. It will be open to all public high school teachers who attended the 2007 Convergys Oral English Training and he/she will form a team of 15 students. However, only one (1) teacher-coach per school is allowed to join the festival. The Education Supervisor I in English (Secondary) will be in charge of the said activity for the division festival. The winning team/school will be eligible to join the Regional English Jazz Chants Festival.

Phase 2: The winning division team/school is entitled to participate in the REGIONAL ENGLISH JAZZ CHANTS FESTIVAL (REJCF) to be held in **March**, **2008** (see Enclosure 3, REJCF Schedule). The Education Supervisor II in English (Secondary) will lead the activity. Likewise, the ES II endorses/submits the regional winning team/school to the Secretariat of the 2008 National English Jazz Chants Festival using the Official Endorsement Form duly signed. There will only be one (1) winner per region.

Phase 3: There will be 17 teams/schools that will finally compete in the 2008 NATIONAL ENGLISH JAZZ CHANTS FESTIVAL (NEJCF) from the 17 regions. During the NEJCF, group contestants will have their entry piece (free and will not be judged) which will be delivered in their native language for 3 minutes, to be followed by the Competition Piece, then the Original English Jazz Chants. From these, there will be four (4) winners: one (1) from Luzon; one (1) from Visayas; one (1) from Mindanao and one (1) Grand Winner/Champion.

Title of the Competition Piece: **RAIN** (see Enclosure No. 7)
Participants may choose one among the following themes for the original jazz chants:

For English: Parts of Speech; Figures of Speech; Idiomatic Expressions; Pronunciation of Words, Language

For Science: Environment; Life/Water Cycle; Elements & Chemicals **For Math:** Formulas; Equation; Fundamental Operations

Competition Piece and free choice or Original Jazz chants shall be delivered minimum of three (3) minutes and maximum of five (5) minutes each.
