CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL NON-SPECIALIST
TEACHERS IN FILIPINO, ARALING PANLIPUNAN, TECHNOLOGY
AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION (TLE) AND MUSIC, ARTS
AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH (MAPEH)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. Cognizant of the important role the teacher plays in the teaching learning process, this Department, through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and the Regional Offices, in partnership with the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) and Centers of Excellence (COEs), announces the offering of a Two-Summer Certificate Program for Secondary School Non-Specialist Teachers in Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, TLE and MAPEH. Term 1 shall be conducted in summer 2008 and summer 2009 for Term 2.

2. The Certificate Program seeks to improve the capability of teachers who are non-specialists in the four (4) learning areas by providing KSAs and experiences that will increase their knowledge of content and upgrade their competence in teaching and assessment for learning. Follow through interventions at the regional level are expected to be provided during the semestral break as part of the continuing capability-building of teachers.

3. The Certificate Program is a 24-unit program leading to a minor in Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, TLE, and MAPEH. It shall be a six-week course and shall run for two (2) summers. The first term of summer classes shall begin on April 14, 2008 and shall end on May 24, 2008.

4. The selection of participants shall be done by the Regional Offices. The list shall be provided the TEIs for the region, copy furnished the BSE on or before March 15, 2008. The qualification requirements include the following:

- Graduate of teacher education or allied programs with less than 24 units in the subject area (Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, TLE and MAPEH);
- With at least 5 years of teaching experience in any of the aforementioned subjects;
- With a teaching assignment or load in the subject for the last three (3) years;
- Not more than 55 years of age and if female, must not be pregnant;
- Must be eligible (PBET/LET passer) and with a permanent appointment;

- Must sign a training contract with the Schools Division Superintendent; and
- Must be free from any administrative liabilities.

5. The Summer 2008 participants shall undergo the Certificate Program at the selected TEIs or the CHED's Centers of Excellence (COEs) that have been selected as service providers by the regions. The service providers and their learning area offering are listed in Enclosure No. 1

6. Each participant shall be entitled to a stipend of Twelve Thousand Pesos (PhP12,000.00), a book allowance of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) per summer training and a training fee of Eight Thousand Pesos (PhP8,000.00). Funds for the purpose shall be transferred to the Regional Offices.

7. Should a participant opt to earn undergraduate units from the program, he/she should present to the TEI/COE Permit to Study and the undergraduate transcript of records (TORs) and other requirements. Otherwise, only a Certificate of Completion shall be awarded each participant.
