CORRIGENDUM TO DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 58, S. 2008
(Second DepED-MTAP National Conference on Mathematics Education)

1. This is to correct Paragraph No. 4 of DepED Memorandum No. 58, s. 2008 dated February 7, 2008 to read as follows:

A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) shall be charged each participant who will pay on or before **March 14, 2008** and Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) for those whose will pay after March 14 but before **March 29, 2008**. The fee will cover the travel, honoraria, board and lodging of resource persons, meals (from supper of Day 0 to lunch of Day 3) of participants, their lodging, conference materials, certificates of attendance and participation, conference bag and miscellaneous expenses. **Registration fees and travel expenses of each participant shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.** Participation is on a first-come, first-served basis. The organizers cannot guarantee a place to any interested person who has not paid by March 29, 2008. Enclosed is the application form.
