NATIONAL SEMINAR FOR LITERACY WORKERS

To: Bureau Directors Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. The Philippine Normal University (PNU) in cooperation with the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC) of the Philippines will hold a National Seminar for Literacy Workers at the PNU Pecson Hall Auditorium, Taft Avenue, Manila on April 9-11, 2008.
- 2. The seminar aims to:
 - develop understanding of elements in literacy teaching for different types of literacy learners;
 - provide opportunities for literacy workers to learn from "best practices" in literacy teaching;
 - c. enhance the capacity and leadership potential of literacy workers; and
 - e. build stronger and sustainable linkages and connections among literacy workers in the country to facilitate sharing of resources and expertise.
- 3. Expected participants are literacy teachers and volunteers generally involved in nonformal education; NSTP coordinators and facilitators involved in community work and literacy teaching; university faculty in nonformal education; and university extension coordinators.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover fee for snacks and lunch, seminar materials and other expenses to be incurred during the seminar.
- 5. Transportation, per diems, and other allowable expenses incident to participation in this seminar of those coming from government institutions may be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions should make arrangements with their respective offices.
