TRAINING IN COACHING TEAM SPORTS OF THE SPECIAL
PROGRAM IN SPORTS (SPS)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) of the Department of Education shall conduct the Training in Coaching Team Sports for Implementers of the **Special Program in Sports** on May 5-9, 2008 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
2. The training aims to update participants on the latest trends in coaching team sports such as baseball, basketball, football, sepak takraw, softball, and volleyball.
3. The Regional Office shall recommend six (6) coaches from four (4) secondary schools who are implementing the SPS, including the SPS pilot school in the region. Participants should have knowledge and skills in coaching the team sports mentioned in Item no. 2.
4. Board and lodging of participants and training staff, transportation, per diem and extra duty allowance of training staff, training kit, supplies and materials, honoraria of resource persons, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against DepED HRDT funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Transportation and per diem of the participants shall be charged against local funds.
5. Participants who are not recommended by the Regional Office but are interested to participate in the training shall be charged a registration fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) to cover board and lodging, training kit and other training related expenses. Their registration fee, and other incidental expenses to be incurred (by these participants) shall be charged against local funds.
6. The Regional Office through the SED Chief, must send the list of participants to Ms. Rosa Ligaya C. Domingo of the Staff Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education at telefax no. (02) 632-7586 on or before April 18, 2008.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
