2008 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SPED TEACHERS  
OF THE GIFTED AND TALENTED/FAST LEARNERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education (SPED-BEE) announces the Summer Training Program for Special Education (SPED) Teachers of the Gifted and Talented/Fast Learners at the Philippine Normal University (PNU), Taft Avenue, Manila. This training program is a graduate course open to Special Education (SPED) Teachers teaching the gifted and talented/fast learners. It will be conducted in two summers. The first term is from April 14 to May 9, 2008 and the second term is in summer of 2009. Enrolment for the first term is on April 14, 2008 to be followed by a briefing session at the Bureau of Elementary Education Conference Room in the afternoon of the same date. Classes start on April 15, 2008.
2. The program aims to capacitate the SPED Teachers for the gifted with competencies, knowledge and skills in enhancing their teaching abilities to meet the diverse needs of gifted children.
3. Priority nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/schools where there is an urgent need for these SPED Teachers (see Enclosure No. 3). These nominees shall be screened by the existing Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 1. Deadline for submission of nominees to the region is on March 28, 2008. The list of candidates together with the documents and the Memorandum of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (See Enclosure No. 2) shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City on or before April 14, 2008.
4. Grantees under this training are entitled to free tuition fees and a monthly stipend of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) and traveling expenses to and from during the training charged to the Bureau of Elementary Education. Other allowable expenses incident to the participation of the trainees shall be borne by local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

2. Has not been trained yet but actually teaching SPED classes for gifted and talented/fast learners
3. Grade point average of 2.0/85/B in the undergraduate /graduate/post graduate study
4. Is not more than 45 years old
5. Not pregnant or a nursing mother
6. Has no administrative/criminal record
7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and registers positive attitude and commitment toward work, peers and students
8. Willing to conduct and/or assist in-service training activities after scholarship
9. Willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses
10. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years
11. Communicative in both English or Filipino

5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her function upon the completion or termination of the training;

6. Organize SPED programs or classes for gifted and talented/fast learners;
7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least (2) years after the training;
8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to the Department such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine Government if he/she fails to provide educational services to the children with special needs for two (2) years after the summer training; and
9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this scholarship.
