## ANNUAL SEMINAR-CONVENTION IN HOME ECONOMICS

- 1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), a national recognized international member of Asian Regional Home Economics Association (ARAHE) and International Federation of Home Economics (IFHE) will hold a three-day Annual Seminar-Convention in Home Economics (EPP-TLE) on October 17-19, 2008 at Bohol Plaza Resort, Panglao Island, Dayo Hill Mayacabac, Dawis, Bohol.
- 2. In celebration of PHEA's 60<sup>th</sup> year of dynamic existence, the theme of the seminar-convention is "Home Economics: Reflecting the Past Creating the Future". The theme will thoroughly reflect upon its historical notes and will also deliberate the position of home economics, as well as home economics professions at present and for the future.
- 3. The participants to the convention are regional and division supervisors, principals, and school heads of Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP), TLE chairman and coordinators, EPP teachers, Agriculture and Industrial Arts teachers, DepED-TLE scholars representing their respective regions, regional PHEA coordinators and co-coordinators and PHEA regional, division and school level officers. Attendance of the participants shall be on **official time**.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Five Pesos (PhP3,985.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for food and hotel accommodation (which starts 1:00 p.m. of October 17 and ends 4:00 p.m. after the tour and cruise on October 19, 2008), conference kits, certificates, medals/trophies, instructional materials, resource persons, tour and cruise, and other incidental expenses.
- 5. The participants are advised to bring their PHEA membership cards and their regional costume for regional presentation at the socialization hour.
