DepED MEMORANDUM No. 154, s. 2008

110TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROCLAMATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE

- 1. Pursuant to and by virtue of the authority granted by Administrative Order No. 205, the Secretary of the Department of Education (DepED) shall take the lead in planning, coordinating, and implementing the programs and events in celebration of the Independence Day on June 12, 2008. This is a collaborative task with the Office of the President, Department of Tourism, and National Historical Institute. All the departments, bureaus, offices, government agencies, government owned and controlled corporations are hereby enjoined to give full support, assistance, and cooperation to the National Organizing Committee (NOC) in the exercise of its responsibilities and functions towards the success of the celebration.
- 2. The objectives of this year's celebration are to:
 - a. reawaken the Filipino people of their responsibility and patriotic commitment especially the youth to commemorate the heroism, nationalism and self-sacrifice of our forefathers in the struggle for independence;

b. instill in our minds the greatness of our race, the legacy of our heroes and the ideals of nationhood;

c. rally behind the government's Ten Point Agenda to "Beat the Odds" and the country's institutions; and

d. unite and celebrate the freedom and liberty of our Nation.

- 3. As Chairman of the 2008 National Organizing Committee (NOC), the Secretary with the DepED officials (national, regional, divisions), teachers and students will actively participate in the scheduled programs and activities.
- 4. All DepED offices and schools both public and private are hereby requested to display and raise the flag from May 21 to June 30 to support the National Flag Day. Also, significant events in history that led to the proclamation of Independence be taken up in classroom discussions especially in Social Studies, English, Filipino, Values, and MAPEH. Teachers may also conduct related activities such as classroom-based essay writing, poster making, oratorical, declamation and other activities that will enhance the significance of the celebration.

- 5. One of the highlights of the celebration is the awarding ceremonies of the 4th Pambansang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan of which the National Organizing Committee will recognize the outstanding students in their academic and leadership achievements and excellence in their school and community (DepED Memorandum No. 48, s. 2008). Also, a performance concert of the selected First Sining Pambansa Festival participants from the Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA), Regional Pilot School for the Arts (RPSA), Zamboanga City National High School (ZCNHS), Mandaue City School for the Arts (MSA) and the 2nd Rizal National Festival of Excellence Musical Theater National Awardee, Tupi National High School (TNHS) will be held on June 11, 2008 at the Cultural Center of the Philippines (tentative venue).
- 6. The National Capital Region will play a vital role in the success of this very momentous event in our history. The fourteen (14) divisions are requested to join and witness all the scheduled events from May 15, 2008 to June 30, 2008 specifically five hundred (500) students in the Division of Manila who will be Flip Cards presenters during the Parada ng Kalayaan on June 12, 3:00 PM at Quirino Grandstand. (Please see enclosed Program of Activities).
- 7. The transportation/travel expenses of the awardees (17), the Regional Special Events Coordinators or their alternates (17) and the performers from PHSA (30 pax), RPSA (30 pax), ZCNHS (30pax), MSA (30 pax) and TNHS (30pax) shall be charged against local funds (such as but not limited to PTA/PTCA, local school board funds, regional, division MOOE) or maybe sourced out from municipality/city and provincial funds, NGOs, civic spirited clubs, associations and organizations subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Further, expenses for the board and lodging of all the awardees, participants, coordinators, evaluators, judges, NTWC, honoraria (judges, evaluators, emcee, etc.) production cost, and travel expenses of the DepED Secretariat and Technical Working Group, communication, documentation, supplies and materials, preparatory expenses and operational costs for the scheduled date of performance (June 8-12), and rehearsal (April-June) of the participants shall be charged to the 2008 Independence fund allotted by the Department.
- 8. Cognizant of the significance of the National Flag Day and the 110th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence, the Department of Education (DepED) in partnership with the National Historical Institute (NHI), Philippine Information Agency (PIA), Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), Department of Tourism (DOT), and the Heritage Institute Center will conduct a three-day Conference on R.A. 8491 (Philippine Anthem and Flag Code) and Its Implementing Rules and Regulations (please refer to Enclosure No. 2). Enclosure No. 3 is the Registration Form.

VI. Conference Fee:
