## READING ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (RAP) ANNUAL SUMMER CONVENTION

- 1. The Reading Association of the Philippines (RAP), the national affiliate of the International Reading Association, will hold its Annual Summer Convention on April 25-26, 2008 at the College of St. Benilde International Hotel, Manila.
- 2. The theme of the convention is **Reading Assessment and Intervention: Trends and Directions.** The featured speaker is Mr. Eric D. LeMoine, a teacher and a trainer in the teaching of Reading and Technology from Oregon, USA. Noted experts in the field of reading education will be featured during the plenary and concurrent sessions.
- 3. The convention aims to bring together practitioners in reading education, readership, methods and strategies in teaching reading from various parts of the country to share their research and best practices on reading assessment and intervention.
- 4. Participants to this convention are school administrators, chairpersons/department heads, reading program coordinators, Reading professors and classroom teachers in Filipino and in English at all levels. Attendance of public school participants is **on official time only**. Participants coming from private schools shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools and/or sponsoring organizations.
- 5. An on-site registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (3,000.00) will be charged each participant. Discounted rates will be given for early bird registrants and RAP members. This will cover expenses for lunches, snacks, materials, certificates and other incidental expenses. Participants will make their own arrangements for accommodation. The program of activities is enclosed. Since the venue's seating capacity is 400, the participants are encouraged to register early.
