2008 NATIONAL ROVER MOOT

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

- 1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will conduct the 2008 National Rover Moot at the BSP Camp Malagos, Baguio District, Davao City on April 20-26 2008 with the theme "Rover Scouting: For Community Service and Character Building".
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. practice daily good turns to instill a sense of social responsibility among Rover Scouts;
 - prepare Rover Scouts in performing services needed by the provinces, municipalities and barangays;
 - c. improve leadership skills and ability to work as a team; and,
 - d. appreciate the cultural and historical heritage of the host province and city.
- 3. Rovers, Roverettes and Senior Scouts (3rd & 4th Year High School Students), including DepED personnel involved in Scouting, are the participants to this National Scouting event. They will be allowed to attend **on official business.**
- 4. A registration fee of Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP750.00) shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for the program materials, certificates, individual souvenir items and administration costs. A non-refundable but transferable deposit of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) must be paid to the National Office through the Local Councils on or before April 15, 2008. Full payment shall be made upon arrival at the venue. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses are chargeable against local funds or local school board funds or solicited from private organizations.
- 5. The Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Heads are encouraged to send their participants.
