INVITATION TO CONTRIBUTE TO AN ANTHOLOGY OF STORIES ABOUT TEACHING ENGLISH IN PHILIPPINE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Head, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. All teachers of English in the public elementary and high schools are invited to contribute to an anthology of stories entitled "How, How the Carabao: Tales of Teaching English in the Philippines". This anthology is part of a larger research project of ELTNet Philippines, which aims to provide a venue for English Language teachers of Philippine public schools to engage in a dialogue with other teachers of English in the country.
- The guidelines for contributions to the anthology are detailed as follows:
 - Only submissions from English teachers of public elementary and high schools in the Philippines are accepted;
 - Submissions must be on a funny, touching, or inspiring real-life story about teaching English in a public school;
 - c. Submissions must be 2,000 to 3,000 words long (or roughly, an essay of seven to ten letter-size sheets, using Times New Roman font, 12 points, double-spacing);
 - d. Submissions may be sent by email attachment to eltnetphilippines@gmail.com, or mailed to Dr. Isabel Pefianco Martin, Department of English, Ateneo de Manila University, Katipunan Road, Loyola Heights 1108 Quezon City, Philippines. Submissions may also be faxed to (632) 948-8401;
 - e. Writers of stories that are selected for publication shall receive a modest honorarium and a copy of the anthology. The principal of the school to which the teacher-writer belongs shall also receive a modest honorarium and a copy of the anthology;
 - Photos of the teacher-writer and his or her English classes are also welcome;

- g. Stories must be sent with the following information about the teacher-writer and his or her school:
 - Writer's full name
 - Home address
 - Residence phone number
 - Mobile phone number
 - · Email address
- · Name of the writer's school
- · Complete address of the school
- · Name of the school principal
- · Number of years as a teacher of English
- h. The deadline for submission is May 31, 2008.
