2009 SECONDARY EDUCATION CURRICULUM (SEC) TRAINING PROGRAM

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) of this Department announces its multi-level capacity building programs in preparation for the nationwide implementation of the 2009 Secondary Education Curriculum (SEC). the schedule of training is found in Enclosure No. 1.

2. The multi-level core group trainings for teachers, curriculum managers and instructional consultants aim to manage and facilitate the implementation of the curriculum efficiently and effectively and recommend enabling policies to further improve the curriculum whenever necessary. These will equip the participants with the essential knowledge and skills to enable them to perform their roles in the field level trainings in their respective regions.

On the other hand, the objective of the Training of 3rd Year Teachers of the 23 SEC Pilot Schools is to effectively pilot test and validate the Year 3 curriculum documents of the 2009 SEC. The focus of said training program shall be on understanding the 2009 SEC framework and its curriculum essentials.

3. The regional office particularly the Office of the Secondary Education Division shall recommend and submit the list of participants (the list should include the name of the participants, their schools, divisions, regions and subject area represented) two weeks before the conduct of the activity following the criteria for the selection of participants.

- a. **Training of 3rd Year Teachers of the 23 RSEC Pilot Schools.** There shall be one (1) participant per learning area (except TLE) of the 23 pilot schools. The participant must be a specialist/major of the subject area represented. Enclosure No. 2 is the list of pilot schools.
- b. **Core Group Training of Teachers.** There shall be two (2) participants per learning area (except TLE) from each of the 17 regions. In the case of MAPEH, there shall be four (4) participants to represent the four components. The participant must be a specialist/major in the area represented; must possess facilitation skills and leadership potentials, must be a first year teacher, preferably from a pilot school and has attended training for pilot implementers.

Note: In the case of ARMM, the regional office shall recommend teachers who have satisfied the first three criteria.

- c. Core Group Training of Curriculum Managers, Regional participation is composed of one (1) Regional Supervisor and one (1) Division Supervisor and two (2) School Principals from each division. The participant must come from a pilot school and has attended training for pilot implementers or from a leader school in the division who possesses the facilitation skills and leadership potentials to conduct training programs at the division level. Substitution of participants is not allowed.
- d. **Core Group Training of Instructional Consultants.** Regional participation is composed of SED Chief/Assistant Chief and one (1) Regional Supervisor and one (1) Division Supervisor per learning area. In the case of MAPEH, there shall be four (4) participants to represent the four components. The participants must have attended the previous training for SEC and possess the facilitation skills and leadership potentials to conduct similar training programs at the division level.

5. All expenses including board and lodging, traveling expenses and per diems of the participants and training staff, honoraria of resource persons, extra duty allowance and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of the training shall be charged against BSE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. ***Participants are advised to take the cheapest means of round trip transportation.***
