#### 2008 NATIONAL CONFERENCE FOR SCIENCE EDUCATORS

To: Regional Directors

- 1. The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), in cooperation with the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), Department of Education-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepED-CSCA) and ABS-CBN-DZMM, will conduct the **2008** National Conference for Science Educators on May 13-17, 2008 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The conference theme is "Crafting Better Science Career Paths for the Youth".
- 2. The conference objectives are to:
  - a. enhance knowledge, skills and attitude of mentors in creating better science career paths for the youth;
  - upgrade performance of mentors in germinating interests of the youth and their communities in choosing and appreciating careers in science;
  - develop a strong sense of commitment among mentors to explore new ideas, adopt diverse discoveries and utilize breakthroughs in science and technology;
  - d. encourage values that focus on the positive application of scientific ideas, discoveries and breakthroughs in everyday life; and,
  - e. strengthen the cooperation and participation of science enthusiasts in worthwhile programs, projects and activities that benefit pupils, students and their communities.
- 3. Activities during the conference include plenary sessions, group dynamics, project studies, interactive workshop, improvisation of science equipment, investigatory project demonstration, and other activities geared toward the achievement of the objectives.

- 4. Participants to the conference are teachers, master teachers, head teachers, department heads and coordinators in science from the different public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide, including school principals, district supervisors, division supervisors and regional supervisors and science enthusiasts.
- 5. Transportation and other incidental expenses, including a registration fee amounting to Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) only which shall be charged each participant to cover accommodation and meals from dinner of Day 0 to breakfast of Day 4, training kits, t-shirts, bags and other expenses of the program, shall be chargeable, subject to availability of funds, against local funds, local school board funds and non-DepED sources.
- 6. Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Heads are encouraged to send participants to the conference. The Regional Supervisors in-charge of the programs and projects in science shall undertake the coordination in the field offices pertinent to their respective participation in the conference.
- 7. Members of the SCAAP National Organizing Committee and DepED-CSCA Secretariat are allowed to travel two (2) days before the start of the conference.
