**PROFILING, MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE SECOND BATCH
OF PUBLIC TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOLS THAT
WILL IMPLEMENT THE STRENGTHENED TECHNICAL-
VOCATIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAM**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Public Technical-Vocational School Administrators/Principals
Chiefs of Divisions, Central Office

1. One Hundred Forty (140) pilot public tech-voc high schools have successfully implemented the Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program (STVEP) nationwide in the school year 2007-2008. In view of this success, the various Regional Directors and Schools Division Superintendents recommended the expansion of the Program to one hundred eighty eight (188) public tech-voc high schools that will comprise the second batch of implementers for the school year 2008-2009.

2. In order to determine the readiness of these schools for the Program, a team composed of the Central Office Tech-Voc Education Task Force (TVETF) Secretariat, Vocational School Administrators/Principals and TLE Supervisors shall conduct the following activities on **April 14-19, 2008** in all regions:

- a) Profiling, monitoring and evaluation of the recommended public tech-voc high schools per region for possible inclusion in the second batch of implementers of the Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program (STVEP);
- b) Inspect the workshop/laboratory rooms and other facilities of the schools;
- c) Conduct validation in terms of availability of TVE teachers to teach the different areas of specialization; and
- d) Monitor the on-going repair and rehabilitation of laboratory buildings of the 140 pilot tech-voc high schools if accessible to the targeted schools for profiling.
