FOURTH NATIONAL CHEERLEADING SEMINAR-WORKSHOP

- 1. The Cheerleading Association of the Philippines, Inc. (CLAP) is sponsoring its Fourth National Cheerleading Seminar-Workshop on April 9-11, 2008 at Miriam College, Katipunan, Quezon City.
