ADDENDA TO DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 154, S. 2008 (110th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence)

- 1. This is to remind all officials and employees of the Department of Education that the Secretary is the Chairman in the celebration of the 110th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence and the DepED as the lead agency in the Flag and Anthem Advocacy Workshop and National Conference for the Respect and Reverence for the Philippine National Flag and Anthem.
- 2. This is to reiterate the attendance of public and private school teachers in Social Studies, MAPEH, Values Education, English, and Filipino, CAT Commandants and Boy/Girl Scout Advisers in the following schedules of Flag and Anthem Advocacy Workshop 2008:
 - April 22-25, 2008 Cluster II (for Region IV-CALABARZON, IV-MIMAROPA, V and NCR) to be held at Banaue Hotel, Banaue, Ifugao. Each division shall send at least 21 delegates;
 - May 5-8, 2008 Cluster III (for Regions VI, VII and VIII) to be held at Mc Arthur Park Beach Hotel, Palo, Leyte. Each division shall send at least 24 delegates;
 - c. May 13-16, 2008 Cluster IV (for Regions IX, X, and Caraga) to be held at the Garden of Malasag, Cagayan de Oro City. Each Division shall send at least 35 delegates; and
 - d. **May 20-23 2008** Cluster V (for Regions XI, XII and ARMM) to be held at Davao City (venue to be announced later). Each division shall send at least 37 delegates.

- 3. The Assistant Regional Directors, Assistant Schools Division/City Superintendents, Education Supervisors in Social Studies, MAPEH, Values Education, English and Filipino, Regional/Division Administrative Officers, Regional/Division Special Events Coordinators and public and private School Heads are encouraged to attend the National Conference on the Respect and Reverence for the Philippine National Flag and Anthem (RA 8491) scheduled on May 25-28, 2008 to be held tentatively at Bayview Park Hotel, Roxas Boulevard, Manila.
- 4. The following are addenda to the said Memorandum:
 - a. A registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (PhP6,000.00) which shall cover the kits, board and lodging of the participants shall be charged to live-in participants while live-out participants shall pay Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) for their kits and meals during the workshop. Registration fee and travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the participants shall be charged to local funds (such as but not limited to PTA/PTCA, local school board funds, regional/division MOOE funds) or maybe sourced from civic spirited associations, clubs, and organizations subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Conference of the Respect and Reverence for the Philippine National Flag and Anthem.

- f. Attendance of the Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents and participants to the National Conference is encouraged during the Flag Disposal Ceremony to be held at DepED Central Office Main Flag Pole on May 28, 2008, 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
