SMART SCHOOLS PROGRAM SMART MENTORS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM II

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED) in cooperation with Smart Communications, Inc., in partnership with Philippine Business for Social Progress (PBSP) and Learn.ph Foundation, Inc. will conduct the 11-month action research course under the Smart Mentors Scholarship Program Batch 2 for selected teachers of the Smart Schools Program.
- 2. Smart Mentors' primary objective is to enhance the knowledge and skills of educators on the application of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) in the development, implementation and evaluation of learning environments and teaching strategies.
- 3. The scholarship covers an action research course that focuses on the application of ICT in the development, implementation and evaluation of learning environments strategies.
- 4. The course lasts for eleven (11) months with a maximum extension period of one (1) month. There will be four phases, which includes:

First Phase

Screening of Submission of Works/Demonstration

of Works; Panel Interview and Selection

Second Phase

Two-week Face-to-Face Intensive Training on ICT-

Enabled Learning Environments

Third Phase

Action Research/Thesis Proposal (on-line)

Fourth Phase :

Final Defense

- 5. Upon completion of the 11-month course under the SMART Mentors Program, the student-faculty shall be awarded a Master of Arts Degree in Instructional Design and Technology (MA-IDT).
- 6. The second phase of the program is the ten-day face-to-face intensive training on ICT-Enabled Learning Environments for the Smart Mentors that will take place from April 28, 2008 to May 9, 2008 to be held at Systems Plus College Foundation, Inc., Angeles City, Pampanga.
- 7. Enclosed is the list of the Smart Mentors Top 25 finalists after the conduct of the first phase undertaken by SMART Communications, PBSP and Learn.ph.

- 8. The cost of participant's travel, meals and accommodation as well as other related expenses during the training shall be borne by the Smart Mentors Scholarship Program thru Learn.ph Foundation, Inc.
