2008 ASEAN YOUTH SCIENCE SUMMIT (AYSS)

To: Regional Directors  
School Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) in cooperation with the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc., and the Philippine Science Journalists Association, Inc. will conduct the Asean Youth Science Summit (AYSS) on July 8-10, 2008, at Traders Hotel, Manila with the theme: **"Power Up for the Future Through Science and Technology"**.

2. The AYSS is a complementary activity of the ASEAN Science and Technology Week Celebration which the Philippines will be hosting, and will involve the science-inclined youth in the country and those coming from the Asean-member nations and dialogue partners from China, India, Japan, Korea, Pakistan, New Zealand, Canada, Australia and the United States (US).

3. The Summit aims to bring together students to raise awareness on the global, regional, and national issues that are presently affecting the Southeast Asian region and the world.

4. Specifically, the Summit aims to:

- a. empower the students to plan their future with the end view of using science and technology to harness the region's natural resources wisely;
- b. serve as a venue to discuss the need to act, with resolve and urgency, on the global and regional issues affecting present and future generations;
- c. enhance cooperation, networking and coordination among the youth towards greater involvement in issues of regional and global concerns; and
- d. entice the youth to be more reflexive and aware of their capacity to act on present as well as future problems and solicit their commitment and participation towards addressing such problems, now and in the future.

5. The participants to the Summit should meet the following qualifications:

- Must be 14-18 years old;
- With outstanding achievement in natural sciences including physics, chemistry, earth science, and all science, within the top 10% of his/her class;
- Grades 9-12;
- With genuine interest in science and research;
- Fluent in English; and
- With recommendation by school principal or academic advisor, or scientists or research institutes.

6. Selected secondary schools invited by the AYSS Organizers (list enclosed) are enjoined to send their participants and support the implementation of the international event for the science-inclined youth.

7. No registration fee is required for all the invited delegates. Likewise, meals and other incidental costs during the Summit will be provided by the Organizers.

8. Transportation expenses for the regional student/teacher participants will be shouldered by the DOST Regional Offices. All regional participants should coordinate with their DOST Regional Office.
