2008 NATIONAL DISABILITY PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION (NDPR) WEEK

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

- 1. The 30th National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week will be observed on July 17-23, 2008 with the theme "Kapag May Access, May Success".
- 2. The event aims to:
 - a. stimulate public awareness and strengthen the involvement of government and non-government organizations, including selfhelp organizations of Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) and the media on disability issues and concerns;
 - b. serve as vehicle of information for programs being implemented by government and non-government organizations that adhere to the promotion of the welfare of PWDs;
 - c. encourage every Filipino citizen to take part in improving the economic and social conditions of the PWDs in our society and in encouraging them to take pro-active roles in nation building; and
 - d. generate full media support and participation in disability concerns.
- 3. The Department of Education (DepED), a member agency of the governing board and the National Council on Disability Affairs (NCDA) shall take part in the implementation of suggested activities lined up for the occasion, to wit:
 - a. Celebration of Holy Mass/Interfaith Service;
 - b. Paligsahan sa Kasaysayan at Kultura Para sa May "K";
 - c. Cultural Show/Photo Exhibit on Successful PWDs;
 - d. Fun Day/Sports Events/Wheelathon;
 - e. Job Fair:
 - f. Lecture Series on Disability-Related Laws/Policies;
 - g. Design Making Contest for "Commemorative Stamps"; and
 - h. Motorcade.

- 4. Schools are encouraged to undertake activities relevant to the theme of the celebration.
- 5. Further, activities to be undertaken should not disrupt classes as stipulated in DepED Order No. 9, s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith.
