CONDUCT OF THE REGIONWIDE NATIONAL ENGLISH PROFICIENCY
PROGRAM (NEPP) TRAINING OF MENTORS AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS
OF THE LOW PERFORMING SCHOOLS

Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. Pursuant to DepED Memorandum Nos. 168 and 169 s. 2008, both dated April 4, 2008, the National English Proficiency Program (NEPP) announces its nationwide conduct of the following activities:

- a. Phase III-English Language Reading and "Gabay" Mentor Training for Grades I to III Teachers;
- b. Phase III-Communicative Language Teaching and "Gabay" Mentoring Program for Grades IV, V and VI; and
- c. Phase IV-Orientation of Administrators to Support the Mentoring Program.

The specific schedules of the training for each region are contained in the enclosure.

2. The training aims to train the teachers of the low performing schools on Communicative Language Teaching (CLT), Beginning and Developmental Reading and "Gabay" Mentoring Program and orient their administrators on School-Based Mentoring Program.

3. The participants to this training are the elementary school teachers who belong to the upper one hundred (100) Grades I-III, one hundred (100) Grades IV-VI who passed the Teachers' English Proficiency Test (TEPT) from the identified low performing schools and selected Elementary School Principals and Schools District Supervisors.

4. The DepED Central Office will provide for the board and lodging and training kits of the participants while their transportation expenses will be charged to local funds.

5. Expenses for this activity such as board and lodging of the participants, transportation expenses and honoraria/extra duty allowance of the Regional Trainers, Regional Technical Working Group (TWG), National Supervising Team and staff, training kits, supplies and other incidental expenses shall be charged against NEPP funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.

6. The Regional Offices thru the NEPP Regional Coordinators are requested to submit the following documents: a) budget proposal; and b) bidding documents for the venue. Likewise, they are required to submit a training completion report after the training.
