ADDENDA AND CORRIGENDA TO DEPED MEMORANDUM NOS. 48 AND 217, S. 2008 (4TH Pambansang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan and 110th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence)

Item Nos. 5, 7 and 8 of Enclosure No. 1 to DepED Memorandum No. 48,
 2008 are hereby corrected and shall read as follows:

- a. Each region is entitled to three (3) nominees to the National Level Competition. The deadline for the submission of entries will be on or before May 26-30, 2008. Each nominee will have to submit a Biodata stating his/her academic and leadership qualifications to be certified by the School Principal, Schools Division/City Superintendent, and finally by the Regional Director (please attach latest 2x2 colored picture. The following certificates, documents such as certifications, justifications for the plaques and medals, and other pertinent papers duly certified by the appropriate authorities shall be submitted by the nominees;
- From the fifty-one (51) regional nominees, the National Committee on Awards will choose five (5) national winners.
 The committee will appoint five (5) evaluators and seven (7) interviewers from different public and private entities/institutions.;

c. Each of the fifty-one (51) semi-finalists will receive Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan medals with a cash prize from the Department of Education;

- d. There will be two (2) stages of selection in the national level:
 - Level 1 (Pre-Screening): five (5) evaluators will screen the pertinent papers of the fifty-one (51) semi-finalists and shall give an oral examination to determine the students' academic and leadership achievements. From here, seventeen (17) students shall be chosen as national finalists.

Level 2 (Final Screening): A panel of Judges composed of seven (7) members shall interview the seventeen (17) national finalists based on the following criteria: Personality and Character (20%), Critical Thinking (10%), Rhetoric (10%), Quality and Content (10%). Five (5) students shall be chosen National Winners of the 4th Pambansang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan.

e. Awarding Ceremonies of the 4th Pambansang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan will be held on June 11, 2008 at the DepED Central Office Bulwagan ng Karunugan, DepED

Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City (tentative).

c. The candidates are expected to bring one (1) business attire, one (1) casual attire, and one (1) Filipiniana/Barong

Tagalog.

d. Expected to arrive at the venue as official delegates from the regions are the Regional Special Events Coordinators or their official representatives and the semi-finalists (3 each region) of the 4th Pambansang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan. Travel expenses of said officials shall be charged to local funds (such as but not limited to Regional/Division funds, school board funds) or may be sourced from civic-spirited associations, clubs and organizations subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules, regulations and procedures.

3. The following are corrigenda to DepED Memorandum No. 217, s. 2008:

a. Northern Mindanao Cluster Flag Advocacy Workshop (Regions IX, X, CARAGA) will be held on July 9-12, 2008 at RELC, Cagayan de Oro City instead of May 13-16, 2008 at Gardens of Malasag, Cagayan de Oro City;

scheduled on May 25-28, 2008 is cancelled;

g. "Huling Parangal sa Watawat" – a Flag Disposal Ceremony will be held on May 28, 2008 at 3:30 p.m. at DepED Central office and to be attended by the NOC/NTWC members, DepED officials and employees, DepED NCR Regional Director, Schools Division/City Superintendents, Education Supervisors in all subject areas, Administrative Officers, Special Events Coordinators, Public and Private School Administrators/Principals, Kalayaan 2008 National Organizing and National Technical Working Committee members, Boy and Girl Scouts of the Philippines, officials, teachers and students (Divisions of Pasig City/San Juan, Mandaluyong, Makati City and Quezon City) and officials and members of the Federation of Student Government; and

- h. All government agencies, schools and field offices of DepED NCR are encouaraged to hand-over to the DepED-SEU all worn-out and faded flags on or before May 26, 2008.

 - a. The theme of this year's observance of Independence Day Celebration is "Republic Service, Tungo sa Ganap na Kalayaan at Kaunlaran";

One hundred (100) DepED officials (national, regional and division) and teachers especially in Social Studies, Values Education, MAPEH, Filipino and English are invited to attend the said program; and
- e. June 19, 2008, 9:00-9:30 a.m. and 3:00-3:30 p.m. Nationwide Telecast of the Rizal Is Alive! On the Knowledge Channel.
