
29TH ANNUAL NATIONAL GRADE SCHOOL CONVENTION AND 50TH ANNUAL

1. The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI), will hold the 29th Annual National Grade School Convention from August 30 to September 3, 2008 and the 50th Annual National Convention of CMLI Junior Members and Teacher-Advisers on October 25-29, 2008 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "Human Rights, Human Rights, Bakit ka Ginawa? CMLI: Empowering the Filipino Youth as Stewards Against the Deprivation of Children's Rights".

The participants to these activities are pupils of public elementary and secondary schools nationwide, school leaders, and active officers/members of the school council, school paper editors/staffers, outstanding honor pupils/students, officers and members of the school organizations who may be recommended by the school principal and their respective Local Government Units (LGUs). Attendance of public school participants is on official time only.
5. The convention fee of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Five Pesos (PhP5,775.00) shall be shouldered by each delegate and teacher adviser to cover expenses for board/lodging, souvenir program, convention kits/materials, modules, certificates, and other incidental expenses.
