CORRECTIONS TO DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 152, S. 2008  
(Distribution of Oral Health Kits to Grade One Pupils in Public Elementary Schools)

1. This serves to correct the following paragraphs of DepED Memorandum No. 152, s. 2008, "Distribution of Oral Health Kits to Grade One Pupils in Public Elementary Schools" issued last March 31, 2008:

**Paragraph 2.** Together with the toothbrush and toothpaste, posters and materials on oral health promotion will be delivered via courier to division offices.


**Paragraph 4.** Delivery to division offices will start June 2008. Please refer to Enclosure No. 1 for delivery schedules. The Schools Division Superintendent, Assistant Schools Division Superintendent/ASP Coordinator, Health and Nutrition Section Heads, Dentists-in-Charge, Nurses-in-Charge, and Supply Officers are the division officials and personnel authorized to receive these packages.

**Paragraph 6.** Upon receipt of these packages, all divisions thru the ASP Coordinator, Health and Nutrition Section Heads, and/or Dentists-in-Charge/Nurses-in-Charge, are enjoined to prepare schedules on its distribution to schools and facilitate timely delivery and accurate documentation (see enclosed sample forms). All packages should be received by schools within the schedule indicated below from the dates the same were received by the division offices:

3. School heads and teachers are also being reminded to observe proper disposal of used toothbrush and empty toothpaste sachets. School heads and teachers may also opt to collect these and participate in a recycling competition/event/campaign that will be launched by CPPI and DepED in October.
