1. Pursuant to Civil Service Commission (CSC) Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 16, s. 1998, DepED Order No. 51, s. 2003, DepED Memorandum No. 23, s. 2002 and DepED Memorandum No. 45, s. 2006, the DepED National Employees Union (DepEDNEU) will conduct its 2nd National Congress and Seminar-Workshop on August 13-15, 2008 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "Responsible Public Sector Unionism, A Catalyst to Achieving Quality Education and Good Governance".
2. The primary aim of the activity is to provide opportunities for wider participation and involvement of all DepED non-teaching personnel in public sector unionism and to:
 - a. promote the continuing partnership between the DepED management and rank-and-file employees in pursuit of quality education goals and targets;
 - b. identify critical areas of cooperation in order to enhance work productivity and improve the delivery of DepED services, especially in the regions;
 - c. strengthen employees awareness on the significance of public sector unionism relative to government workers, education, advancement and advocacy concerning to workers' rights, benefits and privileges as well as their responsibilities; and
 - d. come-up with a short term action plan for the attainment of wage and non-wage benefits including improvement of work conditions for all non-teaching personnel; and
 - e. promote advocacy on programs of government and non-government entities for environmental protection and restoration.
3. Participants to this activity are DepEDNEU officers and members, administrative officers, HRMO's/personnel officers in the central office, regional offices, division offices, public elementary and secondary schools and all other

interested parties who are willing to contribute in the uplift of the welfare of non-teaching personnel in DepED.

4. Attendance to this activity is on official business. A registration fee of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (PhP3,900.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses on kit materials, supplies, rentals of equipment, honoraria, and food and accommodation. Registration at the venue will start at 2:00 p.m. of August 12, 2008. Board and lodging will commence on the evening of August 12, 2008 until breakfast of August 15, 2008.

5. The members of the working committees and secretariat shall be considered participants and shall pay the registration fee. They are authorized to travel two days before the opening day of the convention.

6. Travel expenses, per diem and other contingent expenses are authorized, chargeable against the local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
