- 1. The Department of Education (DePED), in partnership with the Foundation for Information Technology Education and Development, Inc. (FIT-ED) and the University of the Philippines Open University (UPOU), shall conduct the Third National ICTs in Basic Education Congress with the theme "Teaching the Net Generation: Curriculum, Pedagogy, and the Challenge of 21st Century Learning" on September 10-11, 2008 at Waterfront Hotel, Lahug, Cebu City.
- 2. The objective of this biannual two-day event is to provide a forum for stakeholders to exchange views, examine critical issues, and share good practices in designing, initiating, managing, and sustaining ICT-based innovations within the framework of providing quality basic education for all.
- 3. The Congress will showcase existing local and international good practices in ICT and curriculum integration and encourage dialogue on the curricular and pedagogical issues that underpin computer and Web-enabled initiatives towards educational transformation. Interested parties are invited to submit abstracts of paper presentations on experiences in implementing ICT integration programs in schools or alternative learning environments. The Regional ICT coordinators shall consolidate the official list of participants from their region (inclusive of the divisions under their region) and submit to the Congress Secretariat. Members of the Secretariat who are from the Department shall attend **on official business**.

- 5. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP 4,000) is set for public, private and other institution officials and representatives. Registered participants may attend all plenary and concurrent sessions and are entitled to a congress kit, two lunches and 4 snacks. Participants who pay the registration fee on or before August 15, 2008 will be given a discount of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 500). - 6. Due to the limited number of slots, DepED participants will be guaranteed the same only upon remittance of the registration fee.
