18TH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PAMBANSANG SAMAHAN PARA SA EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAHALAGA (PSEP, INC.)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Pambansang Samahan para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (PSEP, Inc.) will hold its 18th Annual National Convention on November 26-28, 2008 at Venus Park Hotel, Baguio City with the theme "Pagbabagong Loob Tungo sa Moral at Etikal na Pamumuhay".
- 2. The convention aims to:
 - deepen one's understanding in the development of ethical decision making;
 - b. recognize and appreciate concrete programs and projects that promote values leading to the development of the Filipino moral strength and character;
 - c. commit oneself and deepen one's responsibilities in carrying out various activities and strategies towards ethical living; and
 - d. enhance the student's creative participation in the promotion and preservation of moral and cultural values through different contests.
- 3. The association will also hold its 6th Tagis Talino and Sayawit sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga competitions and the 4th On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest during the convention. Contestants for the Poster-Making are advised to bring their own materials (1/4 illustration board, pencil, eraser, pastel crayons, etc.).
- 4. The 2008 winners of the Search for Outstanding School Based Values Education Program, VE Educator, and Model Kabataang PSEP organization will also be awarded. The guidelines and nomination form for the searchers as well as the tentative convention program are enclosed.
- 5. Participants to this convention are Values Education and Makabayan regional, division and district supervisors, principals, head teachers and teachers-in-charge, VE and Makabayan department heads, coordinators and teachers both in the elementary and secondary levels, guidance counselors, Christian Living and Character Education teachers, PSEP, MPSEP and KPSEP national and local officers and members, PTCA officers and members, students and other interested parties.

- 6. A registration fee of Five Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP5,500.00) shall be charged each PSEP participant and Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) each KPSEP participant. The fee is inclusive of board and lodging, convention materials, honoraria for resource persons and membership fees (for PSEP participants only). The fee is chargeable against local funds, school board funds, and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations subject to the availability of funds.
- 7. Regional directors, schools division/city superintendents and school principals are encouraged to send participants to the convention and contests. The regional and division VE/Makabayan supervisors and coordinators shall undertake the coordination in the field pertaining to their respective delegation and representation.
- 8. The PSEP national officers and organizing committee members are allowed to travel two (2) days in advance to attend to the preliminary preparations for the convention.
- 9. Student-participants to the convention and contests shall be given enough time to prepare for the quizzes and other examinations which they may have missed because of their absences. They shall be allowed reasonable time to comply with the requirements of the different subject areas.
- 10. Pre-registration is required before November 10. Confirmed participants may fax their registration at (02) 527-03-82. Arrival of participants, convention registration and issuance of materials is from 8:00-11:30 am of November 26. The first meal of the convention is lunch of November 26.

PSEP Annual Nationwide Search for Outstanding School-based Values Education Program

Rationale and Objectives: To recognize the outstanding achievements and efforts of schools and institutions in sustaining and strengthening the National Values Education Program.

Guidelines for Implementation: The search is open to all secondary schools in both public and private duly nominated by their respective division head using the prescribed nomination form.

Award and Prizes

The winner shall receive the following awards and prizes:

- 1. A Plaque of Recognition for the School Awardee and its Division.
- Cash prize of <u>Php10,000.00</u> for the winning school.

The awarding ceremony will coincide with the Values Education Convention on November, 2008.

Qualification of Nominee

- The school nominee must be presently offering Values Education both as a separate subject area and as integrated in the core subjects for the last three (3) years or more.
- The school nominee must be recommended by the Division. Only one nominee per division will be accepted by PSEP.

Selection Procedure:

- For the first level. All supporting documents (within the last three (3) years) submitted by the school nominees shall be rated according to a set of criteria presented below:
- Outstanding Implementation of the Values Education Program ——25% (Well-managed VE program, introduced innovations in teaching VE, conducted researches, prepared instructional materials in VE and received awards and recognition)
- Faculty Professional Development Program—25% (qualified teaching staff, provided professional development program, attended Values Education training programs, members of PSEP)
- Student Development Program——25%

 (well-organized K-PSEP group, supported various students' activities—
 youth fora, seminar, convention, etc.)

PSEP Annual Nationwide Search for Outstanding Values Educators

Rationale and Objectives: To recognize the outstanding achievements of Values Education teachers and to encourage others in the field to uplift the quality of teaching Values Education in the country.

Guidelines for Implementation: The search is open to all full-time Values Education department heads and teachers in the elementary, secondary and tertiary schools both public and private duly nominated by their respective school heads and using the prescribed nomination form.

Awards and Prizes

The winner shall receive the following awards and prizes:

- 1. A Plaque of Recognition for the Awardee and the school where he/she comes from.
- Cash prize of Php5, 000.00 for each winner in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels.

The awarding ceremony will coincide with the Values Education Convention on November, 2008.

Qualifications of Nominee

- The nominee must be a Filipino citizen, male or female, presently teaching V.E. and must have taught Values Education in the elementary, secondary or tertiary level, whether in public or private school, for three (3) consecutive years or more.
- 2. The nominee for the award must be recommended by the school head.
- The nominee must be of good moral character as certified by the school head.
- 4. The nominee must not be presently an Officer of Board Member of PSEP.
- Nominees and Finalists in last year's search (except the winners) are still qualified for re-nomination.

Selection Procedure

 For the first level. All supporting documents submitted by the nominees shall be rated according to a set of criteria presented below:
