LEADERSHIP SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR THE NATIONAL SECONDARY
SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS ASSOCIATION (NSSPAA) OFFICERS

To: Regional Directors

1. The National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (NSSPAA) shall conduct the Leadership Seminar-Workshop on August 14-16, 2008 at the Ciudad Christina Resort, San Mateo, Rizal.
2. The seminar-workshop aims to:
 - a. provide a forum for a scholarly exchange of ideas among the participants in order to adopt a journalism training program suited to the needs of the different regions;
 - b. enhance the leadership qualities of the participants;
 - c. address issues and concerns on the practices in journalism of each region; and
 - d. come up with a style book for the conduct of press conference from the division to the national levels.
3. The participants are the regional association presidents of NSSPAA who are not represented in the executive board. They are requested to bring the following:
 - a. list of schools with a school paper;
 - b. list of schools without a school paper;
 - c. courses pursued by graduates of journalism classes;
 - d. training needs by division; and
 - e. materials needed for the development of the style book.
4. The participants are requested to make arrangements for teacher-substitutes to take over their classes during the seminar-workshop.
5. The transportation expenses to and from the participants' station to the venue, per diem, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the local journalism funds or the regional association funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Board and lodging and other expenses relative to the attendance to the seminar-workshop shall be charged to the NSSPAA funds.
