FIRST NASSPHIL STUDENT LEADERS CONGRESS

- 1. The National Association of Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NASSPHIL) announces the holding of its First National Student Leaders Congress on September 26-28, 2008 at Punta Villa Resort, Brgy. Arevalo, Iloilo City. The theme of the congress is "Student Leaders: Taking the Front Line in Responsibility".
- 2. The congress seeks to help student leaders to:
 - a. understand the personal and social responsibility implications of their leadership role in their day-to-day life as students;
 - b. plan their academic and leadership involvement to balance their development in the curricular dimensions and channels or school life; and
 - c. realize their grave responsibility in inspiring excellence in others.
- 3. The participants to this congress are: a) student academic leaders, freshmen-sophomores and juniors-seniors, from select schools from the regions to be identified by the division; b) juniors and seniors from the other public and private high schools; c) faculty advisers or moderators of academic clubs; and d) the joint board of directors (students and administrators) of NASSPHIL. They will manage the congress and act as resource persons for the workshops. Attendance to this congress shall be on official business. Enclosed is the schedule of activities.
- 4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, materials, and other related conference expenses. Meals shall be served from the supper of September 26 until breakfast of September 28. Members of the different committees, as well as the present NASSPHIL officials and Board of Directors are authorized to travel two (2) days before the congress. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local school or local school board funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
