FOR THE MIDDLE-LEVEL MANAGERS

1. The Philippines-Australia Human Resource Development Facility (PAHRDF) through its short term training (STT) agreement with the Department of Education will sponsor the Management Leadership Development Training for the Middle-Level Managers in the central and regional offices. The training will be conducted by the Meralco Management Leadership and Development Center (MMLDC) Foundation, Inc.
2. This capacity development initiative aims to enhance the management and leadership competencies of the participants in:
 - a) demonstrating improved appreciation of their roles, duties, functions, responsibilities and accountabilities in support of the BESRA implementation;
 - b) applying innovative leadership techniques that will facilitate the implementation of BESRA in their respective areas of responsibilities; and
