ZERO CAVITIES, ZERO WASTE (Oral Health and Recycling Project/Contest)

- 1. The Department of Education announces the launching of "Zero Cavities, Zero Waste", an oral health and recycling promotion project/contest in partnership with the Colgate-Palmolive Philippines, Inc. (CPPI). This project aims to promote oral health consciousness and concern for environment among public school children through coming up with creative and innovative ways of converting used Colgate sachets into useful crafts and materials.
- 2. With reference to DepED Memorandum No. 321, s. 2008, all recipient schools of the oral health kits given by Colgate-Palmolive Philippines Inc. (CPPI) are encouraged to collect empty Colgate sachets and participate in the recycling contest that will be launched in October.
- 3. For complete information on the Contest Theme and Mechanics, Timeline, Criteria for judging, prizes and other details regarding the contest, please refer to Enclosure No.1.
- 4. In line with this, all regional and division offices are enjoined to support this campaign/project by encouraging the participation of all public schools nationwide, including public secondary schools. ZERO CAVITIES, ZERO WASTE (Oral Health and Recycling Promotion Project / Contest)

Project / Contest Description

Zero Cavities, Zero Waste Project is an oral health and environmental promotion project which aims to foster care for oral health and environment by encouraging schools and students to recycle used Colgate sachets by turning them into useful things such as (but not limited to) bags, purse, kits, folders and etc.

Used Colgate sachets are not limited to those given by CPPI. Students, schools and divisions are encouraged to collect or gather used Colgate sachets from other sources.

Note that to enable to covert used sachets into crafts, students must be advised to cut sachets properly and wash to clean the sachets to be usable for craft conversion.

The Contest will be launched during the Oral Health Awareness Week (OHAW), which is celebrated on October 5-11, 2008.

Contest Objectives

- Promote Oral Health Awareness by forming a daily tooth brushing habit with fluoride toothpaste such as Colgate.
- Promote care for environment by recycling used toothpaste sachets.
- Promote creativity and teamwork among schools in a division-led activity.

Contest Mechanics

- 1. Contest Theme: Crafting on Colgate Sachets
- 2. Who can join: Contest is open to all DepEd Schools (Public Schools).
- 3. Contest Period: October 1, 2008 to December 12, 2008
- 4. How to Join: Schools interested to join the contest must submit entries with application form to their respective Division Offices on or before November 17, 2008. Contest Application form will made available in the division office or downloaded in DepEd website. Please see application form enclosed.
- 5. All entries should be original creations of the participating DepEd School/s, depicting the central theme mentioned above.
- 6. To participate, school must submit at least three (3) items. Each of the three (3) items will be considered as separate entries. Each item must make use of at least 150 pieces of sachets.
- Materials to be utilized should primarily use Colgate sachets, regardless of variant.
 Participants are not allowed to use any other sachet brands. Use of other sachet brands will be automatically disqualified.

- 8. Submission of Entry: Description and Photo (or possibly the real craft) of the craft will be sent...
 - First Elimination: by School to Division Offices
 - Second Elimination: by Division to Region
 - Third Elimination: by Region to the Central Office.
- 9. Criteria for Judging is as follows:

Innovation / Originality — Item must capture attention. It should show the use of imagination. Item must have an inviting show of design and color combination.	30%
Usefulness — Item created / developed must serve practical purpose for any person's daily life.	30%
Workmanship Item must be neatly made and should show quality of work.	20%
Brand Visibility – Item must clearly depict the show of Colgate brand.	10%
Extent of Use of Colgate Sachets The more sachets used the better.	10%
Total	100%

- Judges shall choose the winning entries based on the Criteria for Judging, mentioned in the preceding section.
- Decision of the judges in the division, regional, and national levels shall be final.
