CENTER FOR EDUCATIONAL MEASUREMENT, INC. (CEM) NATIONAL WORKSHOPS
ON USING DATA TO IMPROVE LEARNING
AND INSTRUCTION

To: Bureau Directors

- 1. The Center for Educational Measurement, Inc., in cooperation with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Education (DepED), announces the conduct of the **National Workshops for School Principals and Teachers** on October 16 and 17, respectively at the Isla Ballroom of the EDSA Shangri-La Hotel in Mandaluyong City.
- 2. Generally, the workshop theme "Strengthening Our Use of Data and School Improvement Plans", aims to develop awareness of ways in which schools need to use data to guide school improvement planning and instructional decision-making in order to increase student achievement. Specifically, it aims to:
 - a. review critical decision points in the school improvement planning process;
 - b. practice with a graphic organizer to illustrate the big picture of current efforts and make sure everything fits;
 - c. reflect on current use of data in planning and monitoring processes;
 - d. make important connections between data analysis, curriculum work, professional development, school improvement and classroom practice;
 - e. clarify instructional practices and expectations;
 - f. identify next steps for strengthening use of data in the participants' respective schools; and
 - g. explore the impact of a proactive approach to tell "the rest of the story."
- 3. The Principals' workshop on October 16, 2008 and Teachers workshop on October 17, 2008 will both be facilitated by Dr. Edie L. Holcomb, an authority on school leadership, improvement and reform. Her expertise on improving student achievement draws on a rich background that includes: a) teaching at all grade levels including children with multiple disabilities; b) coordinating services for gifted students; c) school-and district-level administration; and d) consultative work on the implementation of school improvement efforts throughout the United States, and in Canada, Guam, Sta. Lucia, Hong Kong, and the Philippines. She is currently the Executive Director of Curriculum and Instructional Services in the 23,000 student district of Kenosha, Wisconsin.

- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) will be shouldered by each participant to cover meals and workshop materials. Attendance of public school participants is on official time only.
- 5.
