- 1. The following are additional information on the conduct of the 2008 National Population Quiz:
  - a. Date and venue
     The conduct of the National POPQUIZ has been changed from October 14-17, 2008 to October 17-20, 2008 at Bohol Tropics Resort in Tagbilaran City;
  - b. The participants who are arriving on October 16, 2008 shall be accommodated at Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School, free of charge, except their meals. The official date however, starts on October 17, 2008 with dinner as the 1<sup>st</sup> meal;
  - c. The participants shall bring regional costume which will be used during the motorcade;
  - d. The official billeting area is Bohol Tropics Resort in Tagbilaran City. Registration of participants will be from 1:00 p.m. onwards at the hotel's designated area;
  - e. The participants shall fax their schedule of arrival and point of entry in Tagbilaran City where they will be met by the hotel's shuttle;
  - f. The official entries of the regional winners of the essay writing contest shall be submitted to this Office not later than October 3, 2008; and
  - g. The regional POPED coordinators shall submit the list of official delegates by gender to the Bureau of Secondary Education (attn: Rosalie B. Masilang/Melinda P. Rivera) by fax at Telefax numbers 632-75-86, 636-5172 or 73 on or before October 6, 2008.
