ORIENTATION AND PLANNING CONFERENCE OF THE 45 PUBLIC TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS/PRINCIPALS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Public Technical-Vocational High School Administrators/Principals

- 1. DepED Memorandum No. 353, s. 2008 provided the official list of 280 schools to implement the Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program (STVEP), out of this number, 45 administrators were not able to attend the conference in Cebu City. In line with this, a special Orientation and Planning Conference shall be conducted on October 29-30, 2008 at Ecotech, Cebu City.
- 2. The Orientation and Planning Conference aim to:
  - a. orient the administrators/principals on the programs and project to be carried out in the School Year 2008-2009;
  - b. present to the administrators the Manual of Operations of Public Technical-Vocational High Schools;
  - c. formulate strategic plans to manage and sustain the implementation of the programs and projects; and
  - d. set targets that will include the improvement of student achievement and performance in technical-vocational education.
- 3. The participants in this conference are the administrators/principals of the additional 19 tech-voc schools and those from 261 schools who failed to attend the June 2008 orientation. Participants are hereby enjoined to strictly adhere with the enclosed official list of participants.
- 4. The participants are requested to bring their respective School Improvement Plans (SIP) and Annual Implementation Plans (AIP) which will be used in formulating strategic plans. Likewise, they are also instructed to submit First Quarter Updated Reports and list of teachers who need to be trained and their specialization to the Task Force Secretariat during the conference. Check-in will be in the morning of October 29, 2008. The Opening Program will start at 10:00 am.
- 5. Expenses for the board and lodging of participants shall be charged against (HRTD) funds while transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
