READING ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (RAP) MIDYEAR DEMOFEST

- 1. The Reading Association of the Philippines (RAP), the national affiliate of the International Reading Association (IRA), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepED) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) will hold its Midyear Demofest on November 7-8, 2008 in Palawan State University, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.
- 2. This convention of RAP members and reading teachers/professors in Filipino and English is on the theme: "Pathways to Literacy". Noted experts in the field of reading education will be featured during the plenary and concurrent sessions.
- 3. The convention aims to bring together practitioners in reading education, readership, methods and strategies in teaching reading from various parts of the country to share their research and best practices on different modes of instruction delivery on literacy.
- 4. Participants to this convention are school administrators, chairpersons/department heads, reading program coordinators, reading professors and classroom teachers in Filipino and in English at all levels.
- 5. An on-site registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) will be charged each participant. Discounted rates will be given to early bird registrants and RAP members. This will cover expenses for lunch, snacks, materials, certificates and other incidental expenses. Participants will make their own arrangements for accommodation. The program of activities and registration rates are enclosed. Since the venue's seating capacity is 400, the participants are encouraged to register early.
- 6. Travel expenses incident to the attendance in the convention shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants coming from private schools

shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools and/or sponsoring organizations.
