PHILIPPINE COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS (PCP) SUPPORT TO DEPED EXPANDED
UNIVERSAL MEDICAL AND DENTAL CHECK UP (EUMDC) PROGRAM

1. In line with the Health Education Reform Order (HERO) and in support of the Expanded Universal Medical and Dental Check-up (EUMDC) of this Department, the Philippine College of Physicians (PCP), through its local chapters, committed and volunteered to conduct health education and medical examinations in selected public schools nationwide. This is part of the provisions of the Memorandum of Cooperation signed between DepED and PCP in September 2008 which emphasizes the importance of health and nutrition in improving pupil performance.
2. Members of PCP local chapters shall be visiting identified public schools to conduct the following activities as part of the HERO roll out:
 - a. health education lectures using HERO modules to cover the top 10 causes of diseases; and
 - b. medical check-up of all pupils, teachers and school personnel.
3. Officers and members of the local PCP chapters shall be contacting the concerned division offices and schools to discuss details and other administrative arrangements. In line with this, schools division superintendents and principals of concerned schools (see enclosed list and schedule) are enjoined to provide the necessary coordination, cooperation, and support towards the successful conduct of these activities in targeted schools.
4. Schools division superintendents are also enjoined to ensure that Division Health and Nutrition Unit personnel will participate and assist PCP volunteers during the identified dates. Moreover, pupil health cards/records should be made available by school heads on the dates of these scheduled visits by volunteers.

5. Please see enclosure for schedules and identified regions, divisions, and schools. For regions and divisions with no schedules yet, PCP representatives shall be getting in touch with the region and division offices to discuss the details.
