ANTI-GRAFT AND CORRUPTION SEMINARS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Schools District Supervisors

1. Pursuant to the Arroyo Administration's on-going thrust for Good Governance and Against Graft and Corruption and in recognition of the seminar efforts of the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV) to that end by conducting comprehensive 2-Day Anti-Graft and Corruption Seminars in various government offices, agencies and departments, based on the Memorandum of Agreement between the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV) and the Office of the Ombudsman, it is hereby directed that:

- a. The same seminars be conducted in all school districts, divisions and regions throughout the country;
- b. The seminars may be held at any convenient time and place to be determined by the host district, division or regional office, preferably in an enclosed area with an effective sound system;
- c. To achieve the maximum desired effect, all officers, staff, personnel and teachers will be required to attend said seminars;
- d. The host district, division or regional office will provide simple and modest housing provisions and accommodations for the seminar's training staff, which will come from the CRFV/Ombudsman-Corruption Prevention Unit and will consist of four or five trainers and one secretariat assistant; and
- e. A seminar fee in the amount of Fifty Pesos (PhP50.00) will be charged each participant to cover certificate printing, administrative and operational expenses.
