- 1. The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepED) announces the celebration of the National Arts Month (NAM) on February 2009 which will be called the Philippine International Arts Festival (PIAF) this year to profile its international face.
- 2. The objective of this year's celebration is to encourage and promote art awareness of the student sector through NAM Culture Page Writing Competition for Secondary Students.
- 3. The following are the Guidelines for the Competition:

 a. Culture Page entries must come from a recognized school paper from any secondary school;

b. The Culture Page may be written in English and/or Filipino, may contain two or more articles on Philippine arts and culture in a section of the newsletter/school paper, must at least carry a backgrounder story on the National Arts Month (NAM) through Presidential Proclamation No. 683 in 1991;

c. The page may include poetry, cartoon, features, essays, photos, innovative researches on the arts, traditions, heritage, habit, customs of the community, and other literary works. Application of culture to sensitize the community to the United Nations Millennium Development Goals and an outlet for diversity of their artistic expression is also encouraged;

d. Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

I.	Substance/Depth	- 40%
II.	Visual Appeal	- 25%
III.	Creativity (Writing Style)	- 15%
IV.	Originality	- 10%
V.	Correctness (Language Use)	- 10%

Application of culture to sensitize the community to the United Nations Millennium Development Goals and an outlet for diversity of their artistic expression is also encouraged;

d. Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

I.	Substance/Depth	- 40%
II.	Visual Appeal	- 25%
III.	Creativity (Writing Style)	- 15%
IV.	Originality	- 10%
V.	Correctness (Language Use)	- 10%

e. Submission of entries is on February 12, 2009. Entries must be in hardcopy (4 copies) and in CD format. Final judging of

winners will be on February 25, 2009;

f. Enclosed is the Confirmation Letter to be filled up and submitted in hard copy or e-mail to NCCA through Mr. Rene Napeňas, Head of NCCA-Public Affairs Information Office (PAIO) and/or Ms. Brenda G. Corpus, NAM Coordinator for Culture Page Competition until January 31, 2009 to show intent of participation. E-mail entries to ncca,paio@gmail.com and/or ncca.paio@yahoo.com. Snail mail to: NCCA Bldg. 633 Gen. Luna St., Intramuros, Manila.

g. The following are the prizes:
