6<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL ROVER MOOT

To: Regional Directors

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will conduct the 6<sup>th</sup> National Rover Moot at Camp Samal, Tumauini, Isabela on April 14-19, 2009 with the theme **"Scouts: Creating a Better World"**.
2. This activity aims to:
  - a. practice daily good turns to instill a sense of social responsibility among Rover Scouts;
  - b. prepare Rover Scouts in performing services needed by the provinces, municipalities and barangays;
  - c. improve leadership skills and ability to work as a team; and
  - d. appreciate the cultural and historical heritage of the host province.
3. Rovers, Roverettes and Senior Scouts (3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year High Schools Students), including DepED personnel involved in Scouting, are authorized to attend and participate in this National Scouting event **on official business**.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (PhP1,000.00) shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for the program materials, certificates, individual souvenir items and administration costs. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses are chargeable against local funds or local school board funds or solicited from private organizations.
