WORKSHOP AND ACTION PLANNING WITH THE TOP 3
REGIONAL ICT TECH-VOC HIGH SCHOOLS

1. In support to the ICT4E Program objectives of this Department for Tech-Voc Education to integrate ICT into the curriculum and per results of the DepED Memorandum No. 550, s. 2008, a workshop and action planning of the top three (3) Regional ICT tech-voc high schools shall be conducted on March 18-21, 2009 at DepED Ecotech Center, Lahug, Cebu City.
2. The specific objectives of this workshop and action planning are to:
 - a. present to the participants the DepEd ICT4E Strategic Plan and of its objectives for tech-voc education;
 - b. inform the participants on the basis of evaluation of tech-voc high schools in selecting the top Regional ICT schools;
 - c. discuss the regional ranking results and provide a situationer of tech-voc high schools in terms of ICT facilities and teachers readiness;
 - d. identify additional specializations to be offered by the Regional ICT schools according to their capability and readiness;
 - e. provide the schools with the IT Academy requirements;
 - f. develop/draft Implementation Framework and Guidelines on the Operationalization of Regional ICT TVHS; and
 - g. formulate a School Implementation Plan for SY 2009-2012.
3. The participants to this activity are the following (see enclosure):
 - a. Principals of top 3 schools
 - b. Designated School ICT Coordinator
 - c. Selected members of the ICT-Technical Committee and TVE Task Force
4. The Implementation Framework and Guidelines and the three-year School Implementation Plan shall be the major outputs of the participants which shall serve as the basis of their activities for the years to come.

5. The 16 Regional ICT TVHS were determined based on the evaluation criteria developed by the ICT Monitoring Officers and TVE Task Force Members which are anchored with the requirements set forth by the existing ICT industry partners of the Department such as the Microsoft Philippines, Cisco Networking Systems and TESDA.

6. In determining the Regional ICT TVHS, the following criteria were used:

- a. 35% for functional ICT facilities (no. of functional Pentium 4 PCs, no. of PCs connected to the internet, and other ICT facilities used for instruction);
- b. 35% for teachers readiness (no. of teachers trained and certified locally and internationally);
- c. 15% for sustainability (schools efficiency for PC maintenance, no. of support solicited from stakeholders and linkages established); and
- d. 15% for MO rating (strategic location, accessibility, hosting capability, administration support, reports available, safety and security concerns, recognitions received, ICT competition won, and other accomplishments).

8. The opening program shall start at exactly 9:00 am of March 18, 2009, thus, participants are expected to be at the venue on or before the scheduled time.

9. Transportation and other travel-related expenses of the participants are chargeable against local funds. Board and lodging expenses, honoraria, travel and per diem of facilitators, resource persons, and project staff, supplies, function room rental, contingency and other incidental expenses are chargeable against OSEC Tech-Voc Funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing procedures.
