- 4. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the cost of board and lodging. Other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. An advisory of each conference shall be issued prior to the scheduled dates. This will include reports for submission and presentation, the estimated time of arrival/departure, first and last meals and other reminders for the participants.
