CREATIVITY SUMMIT AND WORKSHOP ON KALAHI CULTURAL CARE-GIVING

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Special Program in the Arts (SPA) Lead Schools

1. Presidential Proclamation No. 1262 was issued by President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo declaring March 21-27, 2007 and every year thereafter as United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization and the International Theatre Institute (UNESCO-ITI) World Theatre Week in the Philippines.
2. As part of the celebration, an annual Creativity Summit and Workshop on KALAHI Cultural Care-Giving focused on the United Nations Millennium Development Goals will be held on March 25-29, 2009 at the Clamshell I and II, Intramuros, Manila.
3. This summit and workshop aims to give appropriate orientation to artist-teachers, media leaders, cultural workers and scholars, social activists and human rights advocates on the DREAMS Methodology of cultural care giving for poverty alleviation through capacity confidence building in promoting creative industries and value-laden performances.
4. Each of the 17 Special Program in the Arts (SPA) lead schools shall send one teacher and one third year student to the summit and workshop. Participants in the "Pangalawang Pampaaralang Sining Pambansa" who attended the session on Cultural Care-Giving as well as teachers and students from nearby SPA schools are encouraged to attend.
5. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP1,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks and kit for the said event. Registration fee, transportation, per diem and other incidental expenses to be incurred by the participants shall be charged against local funds. Accommodation in a nearby school will be arranged.
