- 1. The Reading Association of the Philippines (RAP), the national affiliate of the International Reading Association (IRA), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepED) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) will hold its Annual Summer Convention on April 24-25, 2009 at the St. Paul's University, Manila with the theme "Developing Reading Comprehension Across Levels".
- 2. The convention aims to bring together practitioners in reading education, readership, methods and strategies in teaching reading from various parts of the country to share their research and best practices on reading assessment and intervention.
